BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT

Patrick D. McBurney, Jr., age 34, is the son of Patrick and Donna McBurney of Kennewick, Washington. Mr. McBurney was born in San Pedro, California, and grew up in Southern California until 1977, when he and his family moved to Kennewick, Washington. Mr. McBurney attended elementary and secondary schools in each of the three tri-city school districts. He graduated from Hanford High School in 1984.

Mr. McBurney attended Seattle Pacific University and graduated with a Bachelor's degree in political science and sociology in 1988. He received his law degree from the University of Idaho Law School in 1992. After Law School Mr. McBurney returned to the Seattle area. After spending time working on Sid Morrison's campaign for Governor, Mr. McBurney practiced law in the Seattle area from May 1993 through June 1994.

In late 1994 Mr. McBurney returned to the Tri-City area. On July 29, 1995 Mr. McBurney opened his current law practice in Pasco, Washington emphasizing, bankruptcy, criminal law, and domestic relations. On average Mr. McBurney represents between 90 to 100 clients in various bankruptcy matters annually, including chapter 7s and chapter 13s, and adversary litigation. Mr. McBurney moved his practice to Richland, Washington in December of 1999 and is continuing to emphasize bankruptcy work in addition to his criminal and domestic practice.

In May of 1999 Mr. McBurney married Julie Ann Simpson, who is an instructor in the Business Technology Department at Columbia Basin College. They live in Richland, Washington.
