




The Court being mindful that the Judicial Conference of the United States has published its Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule effective 1/1/2005 that prescribes fees for electronic public access to court records, and further being mindful that the Judicial Conference also provided that for good cause the court could exempt persons or class of persons from the fees in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to such information;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any indigent, bankruptcy case trustee, individual researcher associated with an educational institution, court, section 501(c)(3) non for profit organization or pro bono ADR neutral wishing to be exempted from the payment of fees for electronic public access shall file an ex parte motion with the court along with an affidavit or statement under penalty of perjury setting forth good cause as described in the Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule published by the Judicial Conference of the United States pursuant to 28 USC 1930(b). An entity representing a class of persons identified above may also file the motion on behalf of the class.
