

## ACCEPTED METHODS OF FEE PAYMENT

Payment of filing fees from debtors must be paid by cashier's check or money order in U.S. funds, payable to "**Clerk, United States Court**" for exact payment or "not to exceed" amounts only. Payment of fees by credit cards and debit cards from Visa, MasterCard and American Express are accepted for all payments, except from the debtor. Electronically filed items requiring a fee must be paid using the *Pay.Gov* system. The Court does not accept cash or check for payment.

Payment for copy fees and requests for certification of documents can be made over the telephone. If payment is made over the telephone by credit card, the card name, card number, expiration date and security code must be provided. The clerk's office does not retain or store credit card information.

If payment is made by cashier's check or money order, remit payment in the exact amount, include the case number on the payment document and mail to:
