ACCEPTED METHODS OF FEE PAYMENT

Payment of court fees (filing fees and installment payments, copies, recordings of hearings, etc.) may be made online using the <u>Pay.Gov</u> system. Accepted methods of payment are debit card, PayPal, or ACH (electronic payment from a bank account).

Payment of fees by credit card or debit card are accepted in the Spokane clerk's office for all payments, except credit card payments from the debtor.

Registered users of CM/ECF must pay for items requiring a fee using the Pay.Gov system accessible through the user's E-Filing account.

Payment for copy fees and requests for certification of documents can be made over the telephone by debit or credit card. The card name, card number, expiration date and security code must be provided. The clerk's office does not retain or store payment card information.

Payments may be paid by cashier's check or money order in U.S. funds, payable to "Clerk, United States Court" for exact payment or "not to exceed" amounts only. If payment is made by cashier's check or money order, remit payment in the exact amount, include the case number on the payment document and mail to:

A \$53.00 fee will be assessed for all dishonored and returned items.

The Court does not accept cash or personal checks for payment.
