

It has come to the attention of the court that numerous adversary proceedings have been commenced by Jack R. Reeves in his capacity as Chapter 7 Trustee of Health Link, the North Side Medical Services Organization, and the North Side Network, Cause No. 98-06581-W1R. Most, but not all, of those hundreds of adversary proceedings allege the same cause of action, i.e. preferential payments under 11 U.S.C. § 547 and recovery by plaintiff under 11 U.S.C. § 550. In order to reach a just, speedy and inexpensive final result in each case it is necessary that a Case Management Plan be developed for those adversary proceedings which are related or similar in nature. That Case Management Plan will replace Local Rule 7016-1 in those adversary proceedings identified by counsel as being related or similar in nature and will generally govern the administration of the cases.
