




Local Rule 2016-1 Compensation of Professionals, and Local Rule 2083-1 Distributions and Payments by the Chapter 13 Trustee, have been changed and Rule 4001-3 Relief From Co-Debtor Stay is new and are hereby adopted for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Washington pursuant with that certain General Order of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Washington dated March 6, 1996, FRBP 8018 and 9029, FRCP 83 and USC 2071.

Rules 2016-1, 2083-1 and 4001-3 shall be effective June 1, 2003 and shall govern all pending matters, except to the extent, in the opinion of the Court, that their application in a case pending on June 1, 2003 would not be feasible or would work an injustice, in which event the procedure set forth in the former rule shall apply.
