Hearings

(b) Notice of Hearing

Hearings are set by the Court, and the requesting party shall be advised of the setting by the Court. As soon as possible after receiving the setting information, but in no event later than seven (7) days prior to the hearing, the requesting party shall serve notice of the setting on all parties to the hearing. The party giving such notice shall promptly file an affidavit or statement under penalty of perjury of service that specifies when and to whom notice was served along with a copy of the notice, unless electronically linked.

Note: This is to eliminate the need for a party who electronically links the notice to file the notice itself, and is in line with the similar rule in LBR 2002-1(b)(3).
